

# Apply now for the \$3,000 Small Business Recovery Grant

See eligibility



The new **Small Business Recovery Grant** for up to **\$3,000** is now open for applications to help you rebuild your business.

You can use it to cover:

- marketing and advertising expenses
- fit-out changes
- staff training expenses to work in a COVID Safe way

If you're a small business owner in an industry that's been highly impacted by COVID-19 you may be eligible for this grant. **Applications close 16 August 2020**.

#### **Become a COVID Safe Business**

Let customers know they can **safely do business with you** by downloading and completing your **COVID-19 Safety Plan**. There are different plans available for different industries, each has useful advice for creating a COVID Safe workplace.

Once you have completed your COVID-19 Safety Plan, register it online. Then **promote that you're a COVID Safe business** by displaying a badge and poster on your premises.

## Apply for COVID-19 Land Tax relief

If you're a commercial or residential landlord who has reduced your tenants' rent due to

COVID-19, you may be eligible for land tax relief: up to 25% of your 2020 land tax liability and a 3 month deferment on paying your land tax.

This relief applies to landlords who agreed to a rent reduction without any requirement for it to be paid back later.
